SENATE PASSES RECORD TAX BILL BY UNANIMOUS VOTE

The increased yield at \$6,851,700,000. By committee the bill as passed by the House would add \$6,291,000,000 to the Treasury's receipts. Existing levies are expected to bring in about \$17,000,000,000 a year.

BELOW TOTAL ASKED

The total as the Treasury estimated it was well below what it had asked for. In fact, Treasury recommendations took a beating all along the way. To compensate for this, Secretary Morgenthau announced a few days ago that as soon as the bill was out of the way, a new revenue bill yielding \$6,000,000,000 would be requested.

In all the Senate spent five days discussing and passing a bill which itself filled 575 pages. It teemed with technicalities and complexities. The Senate was for the most part, however, content to follow the lead of George and the Finance Committee and excepting one point—the taxation of future issues of State and municipal bonds, which the committee had recommended—generally enacted its recommendations.

The next step in the measure's consideration is a conference of agents of both House and Senate for the purpose of reconciling conflicting rates and language in the differing tax bills passed by the two branches.

ACCORD ON RATES

In one very important respect, however, there was no disagreement. Both Houses approved identical normal rates and surtax rates for individual incomes, and under congressional rules these cannot be changed in conference.

In the last important action before the final roll call, the Senate adopted a series of clarifying amendments to the law regulating the renegotiation of war contracts to prevent excessive profits.

Under the present statute, the Government can reopen such contracts as late as five years after the end of the war. The Senate adopted an amendment, however, declaring that renegotiation shall not be started later than one year after the close of the fiscal year in which the contract is completed.

UNSURE OF EARNINGS

The amendment was designed to meet complaints that contractors found it difficult to obtain private financing because they never were sure of their final earnings.

The Senate named Senators George (D.Ga.) Walsh (D.Mass.) Berkeley (D.Ky.) Connally (D.Tex.), La Follette (Prog.Wis.), Casper (R.Kan.) and Vandenberg (R.Mich.) to represent it in conferences with House agents. The House is expected to name its members of the Conference Committee on Monday.

A major question for the committee is whether to retain the 5 per cent Victory tax which was added to the measure by the Senate.

EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1

The tax would become effective on January 1, would be withheld from pay envelopes and salary checks by employers and paid directly to the Government. In addition to the 5024 exemption, deductions would be allowed for insurance premium payments and debt reduction. Moreover, a portion of the tax would be refunded after the war—for single men 25 per cent to a maximum of \$200, and for married men 40 per cent to a maximum of \$1000.

Both House and Senate adopted the same rates on individual incomes. The normal rate was raised in both measures from 4 to 6 per cent. Both measures would impose the following schedule of surtaxes: First \$2000 (after making usual deductions for personal exemptions, interest payments, contributions, and the like), 13 per cent; second \$2000, 16 per cent; third \$2000, 20 per cent; fourth \$2000, 24 per cent; fifth \$2000, 28 per cent; and on up in income blocks of \$2000 to a maximum surtax of 82 per cent on income in excess of \$5,000,000.

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
