Dear Mr. Stefanski:

Resin QYNV is a polyvinyl chloride resin and, like other vinyl resins, is considered physiologically inert because of its insolubility. It would not be expected to be a skin irritant or an active sensitizer as a result of prolonged or repeated contact with the skin. Similar resins have been used for many years in uses which involve prolonged or repeated contact with the skin without causing any trouble to our knowledge.

The above information would apply to the resin its lf and would not necessarily apply to resinous compounds made in which stabilizers, dyes, or plasticizers are mixed in its composition.

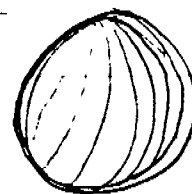
