OSHA VARIANCE REQUEST *DR*

On July 10, 1975, I wrote to you enclosing a variance request we proposed to give to OSHA to eliminate an unexpected problem we encountered with some of the respiratory protective equipment we received

Based upon a meeting Mr G D Lloyd and the undersigned had with various OSHA officials in Washington on July 11, 1975, we have decided not to submit the variance request

Rather, upon the advice of OSHA and counsel (Vedder, Price, Kaufman & Kammholz), we are submitting the attached letter requesting OSHA to provide us with a written clarification and interpretation of the standard This procedure is deemed most expeditious by all concerned

Mr J J Cassidy of Vedder, Price, etc has seen and approved the language of this communication
