

Minutes Meeting 06/04/2022 with ASMoR

The ASMoR representatives expressed their concerns about unexpected consequences of the Generic Approach to Risk Management (GRA), e.g. regrettable substitutions. Furthermore, they suggested an expansion of the discussion about the topic Safe Use and illustrated several issues by providing examples from different industry areas. They also signaled that clarifications on the Essential Use concept and the future role of the Candidate List are necessary.

COM recognized those concerns and referred to ongoing discussions regarding the GRA and essential use concepts as well as the Candidate List. COM also clarified that the Safe Use concept currently follows a minimal exposure path and that further stakeholder discussions are planned during the CARACAL meeting on 20 May 2022.
