MERCED — (UP) — James Roosevelt, generally regarded as one of the leading hopefuls of the Democratic party in the race for the nomination for governor, in 1950, will open a two-day tour of the San Joaquin Valley here Oct. 11.

L. E. Hutchins, county chairman of the Democratic central committee, said the son of the late President will "meet the townspeople as part of a grass roots political survey of the state."

Roosevelt will be the guest at Democratic headquarters in Fresno Oct. 12, where he will speak on policy problems of the Democratic party in California and the nation.

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NEW YORK — (UP) — John Sabo is going to hold a seance with a raven today.

He thinks it will be the most fitting way to commemorate the 100th anniversary of the death of his favorite writer, Edgar Allan Poe.

But this is no ordinary bird. Sabo has on his hands. At least that's what he thinks. He is sure the raven is the ghost of the bird made famous in Poe's poem, "The Raven."

The 57-year-old Hungarian-born chef, who has cooked for two kings that he knows of, is founder and head of the international Edgar Allan Poe fraternity, an organization of persons who translate Poe into just about every language, including Chinese. He's known as the world's foremost translator of Poe into the Hungarian.

"Europeans love Poe," he said, "better than the Americans do."

For years, Sabo has tried to communicate with the ghost of Poe, who has been his literary idol since he was five years old. He had just about decided to forget the whole thing and observe the centennial by going to Baltimore and putting a wreath on Poe's grave, when the jet black raven came bob-bob-bobbing along.

Sabo opened his kitchen door to let in a breeze, and in hobbled the raven. Its feathers were a sight and it had a broken leg. It wasn't the ghost of Poe, but it was the next best thing, and just in time for the anniversary, too.

The chef was delighted. He said he was sure the raven was the ghost of the stranger who "Once Upon a Midnight Dreary" came tapping on Poe's chamber door and chatted in terse caws about a girl named Lenore. Sabo put a splint on the fracture, gave the bird a cardboard box for a nest, and named it E. A. Poe.

He rushed for one of his 250 Poe volumes and found a huge illustrated copy of "The Raven."

"It was the same raven, all right," Sabo said. "It's the weirdest thing that ever happened to me."

Sabo (also known as Taylor,

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
