Dear Oscar:

In my talk with Ellis Locker a few days ago, it turned out that he believed that you were in possession of information indicating that the fatally poisoned man at Artesia, New Mexico had worked inside the storage tank on one or two days preceding the day on which the greater portion of the concrete floor was laid. This matter is referred to in Locher's letter of February 28 addressed to you from San Antonio. Certainly our information gave no clue to any such situation, and if you do have evidence along this line, I would very much appreciate your getting it together for me. I shall be in New York on Tuesday and Wednesday, and you could hand it to me at that time or forward it to me by mail. I believe you will recognize the importance of our having such information, since from my point of view the time of onset of this man's illness was most unusual and almost incredible.
