ADDENDUMS

As per your request on April 10, I sampled the vapor space between the rupture disc and SRV on several vessels in the Vinyl Plant. Only vessels on which the pressure gauge on the R/D showed 0# were tested. In some cases, even when the gauge showed no pressure, a slight seepage could be detected when the bleed valve was opened. These R/D's all showed a presence of organics. Two vessels were found on which the gauge showed 0# and where no seepage or vapors could be detected visually, by touch, or sound. These vapor spaces also showed organics present (see table).

The numbers indicated by the instruments cannot be used as an absolute value since we were unable to keep the instruments from drawing in outside air. In addition, the Century Meter cannot distinguish between various organics such as Vinyl and EDC.
