The data developed by Kuhn/Harmon indicates that our most economical short-term supply point for India will be MCL, rather than Japan.

I recommend that we adopt the policy of supplying from MCL through 1971, and reevaluate again at that time. If we do this, then the customer visits by Benignus/Coleman later this year make further sense.

If you agree, you will want to convey to Durland at some appropriate time.
