This matter having come before the Court on January 17, 2002, pursuant to the Debtors' request for a preliminary injunction following the issuance by the Court of a Temporary Restraining Order dated January 4, 2002, issued pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 362 and 105, in the above-captioned matter (the "Temporary Restraining Order"); notice having been provided as directed by the Temporary Restraining Order; the Temporary Restraining Order having required any opposition to the motion to be filed by January 15, 2002; and responses and/or motions for continuance having been filed on behalf of asbestos claimants by (1) Reaud, Morgan & Quinn; (2) Waters & Kraus, LLP and Kaeske Reeves, LLP; (3) the Unofficial Committee of Select Asbestos Claimants, and (4) Ness, Motley, Loadholt, Richardson & Poole, P.A. (the "Objectors"), and a motion to dismiss under Bankruptcy Rule 7012(b)(6) having been filed on behalf of asbestos claimants represented by Reaud, Morgan & Quinn; and the Debtors and the

Objectors having reached agreement on a continuation of the Temporary Restraining Order and the scheduling of further proceedings, it is hereby:

ORDERED that the Temporary Restraining Order, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein except as expressly modified, is continued with the consent of the Objectors until March 7, 2002, at 5:00 p.m., ET; and it is further

ORDERED that motions to dismiss the Debtors' Complaint shall be filed and served so as to be received by the Debtors on or before February 11, 2002; and it is further

ORDERED that the Debtors shall file its responses to such motions to dismiss and shall serve the same so as to be received on or before February 21, 2002; and it is further

ORDERED that all replies to the Debtors' responses to motions to dismiss shall be filed and served so as to be received on or before February 26, 2002; and it is further

ORDERED that a hearing on the motions to dismiss shall be held in Courtroom A, 600 Grant Street, 54th Floor, Pittsburgh, PA 15219, on March 7, 2002, at 10:00 a.m.; and it is further

ORDERED that a date for the filing of answers to the Debtors' Complaint shall be determined at the hearing scheduled for March 7, 2002, and that no answers need be filed until further order of this Court; and it is further

ORDERED that the status conference previously scheduled in the above-captioned matter for February 13, 2002, at 11:00 a.m. is hereby rescheduled for March 7, 2002, at 10:00 a.m.; and it is further

ORDERED that paragraph 3 of the Temporary Restraining Order is hereby amended and restated in its entirety to read as follows:

"If applicable non-bankruptcy law, an order entered in a non-bankruptcy proceeding, or an agreement fixes a period for commencing or continuing any civil action in a court, other than this Bankruptcy Court, on an asbestos-related personal injury claim against Honeywell that arises from the NAF CO refractory business,

civil action in a court, other than this Bankruptcy Court, on a asbestos-related personal injury claim against Honeywell that arises from the NARCO refractory business, and such period has not expired before the date of this Order, then such period does not expire until the later of (a) the end of such period, including any suspension of such period on or after January 4, 2002; or (b) sixty (60) days after notice of termination or expiration of the injunction granted in decretal paragraph 2 above, with respect to such claim."

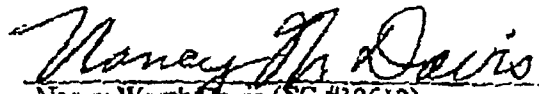
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
