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Air Contamination

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I have discussed further with Dr. Kehoe the question of air contamination at both Deepwater and Baton Rouge, together with some of the general ideas we have on solving the problem.

Dr. Kehoe is quite sympathetic to the general principle of receiving as many contributions as is possible from all sources concerned, and feels, of course, that our technical people should go into the problem and offer their own ideas as to solution.

We both realize that we do not want to do anything that would cause any dissension with duPont on the approach to this problem and Dr. Kehoe has agreed to undertake further discussion with the people in Wilmington toward the end of an acceptable joint problem.

He will be in Wilmington the latter part of this week and will return to Cincinnati on Saturday. If possible, he will contact Dr. Calingaert on Monday, to pass along further views.

Based on all of this then, I would suggest that we bring the matter up for further discussion at our technical meeting here in New York on March 9.
