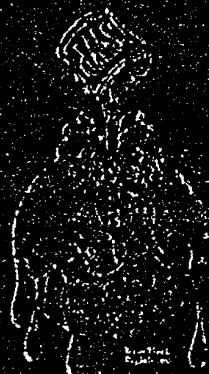

SWP is a prepared house paint of the highest quality in which pure white lead carbonate is combined with two other Sherwin-Williams paint pigments: S-W OZLO (lead-zinc,) and TITANIUM-magnesium, in a practical formulation that has successfully withstood every test in every climate.

S-W OZLO lead-zinc pigment fortifies SWP to control chalking and to make it more resistant to atmospheric discoloration.

In making OZLO pigment from the original ores, Sherwin-Williams fuse lead and zinc into ONE COMBINED PIGMENT which possesses the desired qualities of both metals and is superior to lead and zinc when used as separate pigments in house paint.

TITANIUM-magnesium is an important factor in the clean and lasting whiteness of SWP and its excellent hiding. This pigment also contributes to its toughness and its uniform controlled chalking.

SWP White and SWP Colors are made under the most careful supervision, from pigments, colors, oils, and driers of our own manufacture in order to insure a performance that is uniform and dependable.

SWP UNDERCOATER No. 450 is especially designed for the first coat on new wood, on normal repaint work and is particularly valuable for badly weathered surfaces.

SWP Undercoater contains the same tested pigments used in SWP. The proportions, naturally are different, as would be required for an undercoater.

In SWP Undercoater we have a dual-purpose vehicle in which raw linseed oil (for priming) is combined with a special processed linseed oil (for sealing). With this priming-sealing vehicle is provided a greater pigment concentration so that SWP Undercoater has more actual *build* and *hiding* than can be obtained with either a hand-mixed paint or a house paint reduced for a prime coat.

Thus we are able to *uniform* surfaces in poor condition—to seal exposed wood—to smooth rough, checked surfaces—to dry with a "tooth" over hard, glossy, protected surfaces so that the finish coat goes on quicker, easier and without paint crawling.

SWP Undercoater is made in White only. When used under colors of SWP it should be tinted to a suitable ground color with S-W First Quality Colors in Oil. Another method of tinting the ground coat is by adding one pint of a darker color of SWP to each gallon of Undercoater 450. Browns require a quart of color to the gallon.

SWP is an economical Painters' paint because:

Its close-knit film has stronger hiding and requires less brushing to obtain solid covering.

Its controlled chalking offers the kind of surface which painters like to repaint.

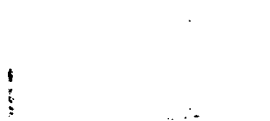

S-W MILDEW RESISTANT PASTE

For adding to exterior paints to treat outside surfaces in localities where mildew exists.

It should be mixed thoroughly into the paint to insure uniform mildew resistance.

Unless mildew conditions are severe, Mildew Resistant Paste should be used in the finish coat only.

Badly mildewed surfaces should first be washed thoroughly with a solution of 8 ounces of tri-sodium phosphate in a gallon of water. Rinse thoroughly and allow to dry before painting.

S-W GLAZ-KALK

For caulking door and window frames, metal sash and chimneys. Especially recommended for repairing cracks in stucco and concrete surfaces.

Glaz-Kalk never becomes brittle and hard like the ordinary putty which cracks and crumbles out. It will not stain. It is applied easily and quickly with a regular inexpensive caulking gun. Cream, Gray and White.

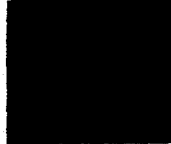

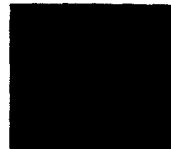

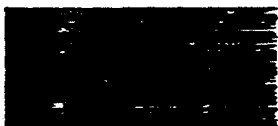

LAMP BLACK

Strongest tinting strength. Tints of a blue-gray tone. By nature slower drying, requiring use of more drier. Use as a base color because of superior opacity.

IVORY DROP BLACK

Although much below Lamp Black in tinting strength Ivory Drop Black is preferred where a pure jet black is required. It is of a brownish cast in tints. Is a good normal drying color.

VAN DYKE BROWN

Yields pleasing taupe shades. Gives a good mahogany tone glazed over Burnt Sienna—makes a beautiful verde antique glazed over Pale Green. Makes an excellent Walnut or Dark Oak Stain over Pine.

BURNT UMBER

Indispensable in obtaining pleasing warm grays or warm tones of brown. A standard graining color—used with Ultramarine Blue it provides a great range of Oak and Walnut shades. Commonly used with Van Dyke Brown. A good glaze color.

RAW SIENNA

Preferred for use with Chrome Yellow Light for Cream and Ivory tints. Combines with Chrome Yellow Medium for soft, rich Colonial Yellow. Used for warming gray tints. Makes a pleasing oyster white with Raw Umber and White. Is effective as a glaze color.

RAW UMBER

Makes clean canary tints without objectionable green hue. Use with Prussian Blue avoiding Ultramarine. Carefully manufactured to prevent discoloring. Strong opacity makes it unsuited for glaze work.

INFORMATION OF INTEREST AND HELP TO THE PAINTER CONCERNING S-W FIRST QUALITY COLORS IN OIL

COBALT BLUE

Is a Cobalt shade of Ultramarine Blue and is lighter and cleaner than Ultramarine. Like Ultramarine, it should not be used for exterior tinting.

ULTRAMARINE BLUE

Not as powerful in tinting as Prussian Blue but indispensable because its "reddish" hue makes it suitable for use with Rose Lake for the violet tints. Suitable for glazing. Use Prussian Blue for exterior tinting.

VERDAS GREEN LIGHT

Verdas Green Light gives attractive shades of emerald green which can not be obtained with Chrome Green, and which are similar to those made with Paris Green. It is, however, non-poisonous, and is fast to light, giving very permanent shades, both of which qualities are very desirable in a green pigment.

CHROME GREEN, LIGHT

Indispensable for producing the clean bright tints such as Lettuce and Satin Green. It lets down to a green when added to white rather than on the blue cast. In modifying with blue use Prussian Blue and avoid Ultramarine which reacts chemically with chrome colors.

CHROME GREEN, MEDIUM

Produces cooler shades such as Jade. Frequently used straight as a wash color.

CHROME GREEN, DARK

A simpler naming of Chrome Greens would designate them as "Yellow," "Medium" and "Blue," the "dark" being the blue grade. It is used principally as a straight color for deep neutral green. It is also useful in obtaining deep shades like Italian Blue. In light tint, it is close to a Robin's Egg Blue.

CARDINAL RED

SHERWIN-WILLIAMS PREPARITE

PREPARITE is a clear, non-abrasive liquid developed specifically to simplify the work of enameling or varnishing over old surfaces.

A cloth moistened with PREPARITE will remove wax, grease, polish, etc., from old surfaces. It does not leave any caustic residue to be neutralized and washed off.

It deadens the gloss of varnish or enamel and temporarily creates a slight tack to which the new finish can bond and anchor firmly without crawling or pulling away.

PREPARITE smooths the old finish without the work and dust of sanding and without the danger of heavy sandpaper scratches or cutting through on edges and corners.

On a glossy surface that is clean, sanding of the old finish may be omitted. Add four ounces of PREPARITE to the gallon of varnish or enamel to insure a deep, firm bond and prevent the customary shelling when applied over an unsanded surface.

PREPARITE should be used on old finishes only—never on a new finish or a between-coat, as it is likely to soften and lift a new film.

STAINCOVER

Staincover is a specially formulated flat white paint that combines the unusual characteristics of an enamel undercoater and a stain sealer. It will hide and seal mahogany, asphaltum or coal tar stain or other surfaces that are difficult to enamel because of the bleeding qualities of stains previously used.

The average stained surface can be satisfactorily sealed with one full coat of Staincover. It may discolor but when dry the stain is thoroughly sealed so that succeeding coats can be applied without danger of discoloration.

Staincover has the hiding of an enamel undercoater and presents an ideal surface for finishing coats of enamels or paints. Should be applied freely, making certain that all checks and cracks are thoroughly filled and sealed. On the edges of moldings where it is difficult to apply a full coat, a second coat should be applied. Under normal drying conditions it can be refinished in 5 to 6 hours.

Staincover is designed specifically for sealing and should only be applied on a thoroughly dry surface. Never mix with succeeding coats of undercoater or enamel.
