Subject VCM DOSIMETRY - JANUARY, 1980

Following are the results of VCM dosimetry during January, 1980. 85 samples were taken, two of which indicated overexposure.

One overexposure of 2.6 ppm was experienced by a Chief Operator in the Vinyl Area. No specific cause of the variance was determined. He was not wearing a respirator.

The second overexposure, amounting to 1.5 ppm, occurred to another Chief Operator who was working in the VCM recovery system. He was wearing a respirator.
