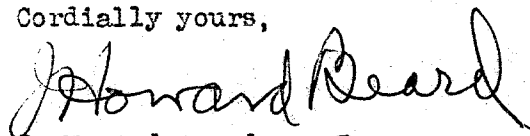
My dear Doctor:
