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1. FIRST OFFERING TO MAN IN CLASSIFICATION ON THE SHIFT SCHEDULED FOR WORK.
2. MEN IN CLASSIFICATION ON "OFF" SHIFTS.
3. MEN OUT OF CLASSIFICATION ON SHIFT SCHEDULED FOR WORK.
4. NEXT MAN IN DEPARTMENT SCHEDULED FOR OVERTIME.
5. NEXT MAN PLANT WIDE SCHEDULED FOR OVERTIME.
