

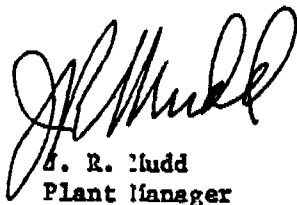

		SUBJECT	Recommended Health Standards 3-11-74

In order to expedite the impact of the proposed standards on our plant, the following responsibilities are assigned:

1. H. E. Jewett - Monitoring typical VCI exposure throughout the plant. We need copious amounts of data this week in order to determine problem areas. Make appropriate recommendations to T. L. Allen for use in economic evaluations.
2. T. L. Allen - Review the proposed recommendations and determine the cost of meeting their proposals. For the time being, you should assume that the Polymer Building and Monomer unloading and transfer will be regulated areas. Include in your study, work clothes, masks, and also any capital costs encountered to comply. Work time lost during a shift should also be considered and if necessary shown as increased manning. You will also have to work with M. C. Bentley on his assignment.
3. M. C. Bentley - Work with T. L. Allen in evaluating the forms and records included in the NIOSH proposals. Also determine the type and number of signs that will be required. W. F. Walker can give you the necessary assistance. I want the total cost of these signs. Be prepared to place an order by Friday.

R. W. Laundrie will be in the plant Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday, so it is extremely important that we have the basic facts and costs by Wednesday. It will be necessary to take some positive steps towards minimizing exposure this week.
