

1 Q Well, do you recall testifying to something
2 to that effect in the past?

3 A Well, something to that effect. Something
4 might have been said which may have been interpreted
5 that way, but as far as OSHA-type fibers, the type of
6 fibers that are regulated, I would think it would not
7 be in that category whatsoever.

8 If it was fibrils, yes, I would believe
9 there could be that many fibrils, but not OSHA
10 fibers.

11 Q Now, earlier you also relied on Dr. Lynch's
12 report that was in 1968?

13 A Yes.

14 Q And I think you said at the time that Dr.
15 Lynch found up to a few percent of free asbestos
16 fibers in his dust sampling of brake work?

17 A He reported that, yes.

18 Q And, in fact, Dr. Lynch found up to about 15
19 percent free asbestos fibers in one of his samples,
20 did he not?

21 A I believe there was one sample that was,
