Dear Mr. Renfro:

In our telephone conversation you indicated that you wanted information on the lead content of "acrylic lacquers" in connection with a workman's compensation claim against a Buick dealer.

Since we sell literally thousands of acrylic lacquers, I limited the search to the most common line of refinish colors, 967/968 Line, used on Buicks in the last four years. A total of 84 colors were used during this period on Buicks. Of these, only 3 contain lead as follows:

<u>Lacite® Acrylic Lacquer</u>	<u>lead (wt.% on total paint)</u>
5009LM Signal Red	1.9
5118LM Fire Red	1.5
5339LM Fire Red	1.4

All other 967/968 Line colors used on Buicks from 1968-1971 are lead-free.
