Status of Study: Completion of the pre-mating period for the Fo
parental animals

Food Consumption: No differences

Mortality: One male in the Aroclor 1242, 100 ppm Group died
during the pre-mating period. No other deaths have
been recorded.

Body Weights: Females in the Aroclor 1254, 100 ppm Group had
slightly lower weights than control females. All
other weights for test females and males compared
favorably to controls.

Comments: The animals were mated on July 18, 1969.
