Gentlemen:

I hardly know how to answer your letter regarding the Licensor agreement on low pressure products.

The proposed set up is apparently designed to operate for the larger manufacturers and I could find no advantages specifically mentioned in the agreement that would offset many apparent disadvantages.

It seemed to give Mr. Tulloch, Jr., the irrevocable control ✓ of my business without any remuneration. The larger producers will pay the greatest commissions to Mr. Tulloch, and it was reasonable for me to believe that the policies and set up would conform to their requirements rather than mine.

We will try and co-operate with every laudable effort to better the general trade conditions and have so notified Mr. Tulloch.

Trust that this answers your letter from the standpoint of a small operator.
