Q. Who are the members of these local boards?

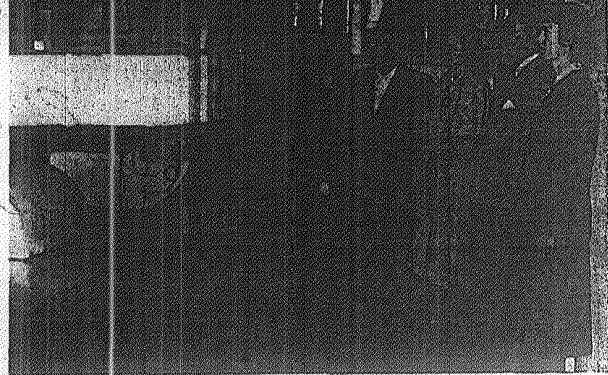

In this area the rent advisory board members are:

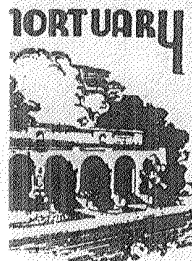
