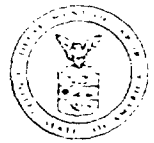

If we do not receive a response from you within five calendar days indicating that appropriate action has been taken, an inspection will be scheduled.

OSHA's policy is to randomly follow up with an inspection in a sample number of cases in which we receive letters of satisfactory abatement action.
