AB - Four selected patients with progressive systemic sclerosis showed deposition of immunoglobulins and complement in diseased renal arteries and arterioles. Although three patients had hypertension, in two of these malignant, the third patient did not have hypertension over a four year period. These findings suggest that immune complexes may be involved in the pathogenesis of some cases of progressive systemic sclerosis, the primary target being the vascular system.

AB - Areas of sclerosis in the phalanges, particularly the terminal phalanges, are common in sarcoidosis despite the rarity of osteosclerotic changes in other bones. Of 37 patients with sarcoidosis with osseous changes of the hands or feet, 20 (54%) has sclerosis either alone or in combination with bone destruction. Of 48 patients with acrosclerosis, 20 (40%) had sarcoidosis. In the authors' experience with a largely black population, sarcoidosis was found to be the most common causes of acrosclerosis.

AB - The joint manifestations of carcinoid tumours become integrated into the carcinoid syndrome, the totality of the symptoms occurring at a distance from the tumour and linked to the metabolites secreted by the tumour. These arthropathies have been the subject of only a very limited number of publications. They consist of arthralgia, sometimes with swelling, predominantly in the extremities of the upper limbs, and linked to activity. The radiological picture includes a "band" of demineralization, and less frequently destructive joint lesions. The sedimentation rate is always increased. These arthropathies can be related to their origin only by knowledge of, and demonstration of, the other

- elements of the carcinoid syndrome and of the tumoro-metastatic syndrome. Laboratory diagnosis rests on determination of the 5-hydroxyl derivatives of tryptophane.

AB - Peripheral blood leukocytes from 12 patients with progressive systemic sclerosis and from 12 normal subjects were cultured in the presence of human skin collagen, lathyrin chick skin collagen, and alpha-chains from chick skin collagen. Leukocytes from 11 of the patients produced a factor chemotactic for human monocytes when cultured with the collagen preparations. The one patient whose cells did not respond to the collagen preparations also failed to respond to other common antigens and was apparently energetic. In addition, lymphocytes from three of the patients were found to transform when cultured with the collagen preparations. These responses were significantly different from the response of leukocytes from normal control subjects. The data suggest that patients with progressive systemic sclerosis may have cellular immunity to collagen.

AB - Scleroderma is reviewed as a complex disease of vascular, connective-tissue, and inflammatory reactions. If the scleroderma syndromes related to occupational, immunologic, inflammatory, metabolic, and genetic factors are recognized, then true progressive systemic scleroderma (PSS) appears to be a disease of vascular fibrosis with secondary inflammatory phases. The primary pathology appears to be a fibromucinous change of the vascular endothelium. The vessels also demonstrate altered reactivity to cold and to serotonin. Biopsy of the skin of the inflammatory or mesenchymal scleroderma may reveal (by positive direct immunofluorescence) deposition of globulins at the basement membrane zone. Evaluation of scleroderma is discussed and a system of clinical staging of PSS is proposed which relates the organ involvement to the prognosis.
