- Contains balanced proportions of Lead, Zinc and Titanium . . . Chalks slowly and evenly — provides an excellent foundation for subsequent coats.

- Dries over night to a firm, full-oil film. Ready to recoat in two to three days during normal drying weather.
- Coverage: Approximately 500-600 sq. ft. per gallon, one coat depending on surface condition.

NO. 600 SUPER WHITE HOUSE PAINT

- This lead-free House Paint, furnished in White only, contains a high percentage of Titanium, celebrated for its extreme whiteness. Where colors are desired, use Lead-Zinc-Titanium House Paint colors.
- Its Zinc Oxide Content retards excessive chalking. Guarantees longer life of film.
- Ideal for industrial districts and dust storm areas. Resists darkening action of fumes and gases, and has exceptional self-cleaning properties, accomplished by the slow wearing away of the paint film which removes dirt by continuously exposing a fresh paint surface.
- Coverage: 500-650 sq. ft. per gallon, one coat.

With both of these fine quality house paints, one coat covers most previously painted surfaces in good condition. On new wood, use Exterior Primer and Sealer for the first coat, followed by one or two coats of House Paint. Where a three-coat job is desirable, apply first a coat of House Paint, followed by a coat of Exterior Primer and Sealer, with a finish coat of House Paint. Where House Paint is used for first coat, thin with two Pints Linseed Oil and one Pint Mineral Spirit Thinner or Turpentine. Substitute Benzol for Turpentine on resinous wood such as hard yellow pine or cypress.
