"Mr. George Cassard, Terminal Superintendent
of General American Tank Storage Company, called
me in New Orleans that he was shipping two samples
of oil to Dr. Kehoe's Laboratory in Cincinnati.
These two samples of motor oil properly labeled,
represent #1 continuous sample taken from pump
while filling storage tank, No. 2 sample of same
oil after being in storage about one month, in
tank that had contained leaded gasoline, that had
been cleaned in a routine manner, but not considered
lead free." (February 15th, 1946)
