My dear Kehoe:

In accordance with your letter of April 17th, I am sending you under separate cover 123 copies of the paper on Normal Lead together with 139 copies Part I. of the tetraethyl lead investigation and two copies of the Bureau of Mines Report.

I think your preface and contents are excellent and it will be fine to have all of this material together in one point. My only suggestion would be the possible inclusion of a brief summary at the end or at the start along such possible lines as:-

- PP* The development of chemical and spectrographic methods for the determination of small quantities of lead in biological material.
- PP* Establishment of existence *general pattern* and magnitude of normal lead *metabolism* in both primitive and civilized man, ~~together with some indication of the sources of this lead.~~
- PP* The behavior of tetraethyl lead in the human organism, *together with the clinical characteristics and the treatment of lead intoxication produced by concentrated tetraethyl lead.*
- PP* The lead hazards associated with the manufacture and blending of tetraethyl lead with gasoline and *the* regulations necessary for safe handling of this material.
- PP* Studies of leaded gasoline the results of which indicate that no likelihood of public health hazard exists from the distribution of this substance as a motor fuel."

I am merely thinking that it will be difficult for anyone not a

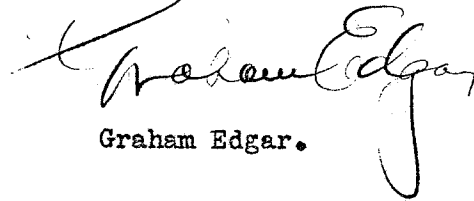
