

1 A Well, I was concerned about the swelling of
2 his legs, and I asked to have a cardiology
3 consultation.

4 That was Dr. Bernard Rubin who is a
5 cardiologist, and Dr. Rubin felt what we were seeing
6 was problems with right heart failure.

7 In addition, Dr. -- and he did not feel that
8 there was very much that we could do for that because
9 he felt that the heart failure was a consequence of
10 his lung disease.

11 In addition, he was given injections of
12 morphine for the first four days in the hospital.

13 Once his pain was controlled, he was once
14 more switched back to the oral form of morphine. He
15 was also given some medication called Lactulose which
16 is a very strong laxative, and he was given a stool
17 softener.

18 And at this point we made a decision that we
19 were not going to intervene, and we were going to try
20 to keep him as comfortable as possible.
