This will evidence our understanding that the carload definition set forth on page 1 of Exhibit B to our agreement dated December 11, 1964, covering "Armstrong LK Insulation" principally, shall be modified to read as follows:

"For shipping and pricing purposes, a carload is defined as one shipment consisting of one or more items appearing on the 'Price Exhibits' in quantities as follows:

Area 'A' Destinations

A value of \$5,000 or more.

Areas 'B' & 'C' Destinations

1. Current minimum 50 foot carload weight as provided in Tariff regulations, or
2. A sufficient quantity to:
 - (a) load one 50 foot rail car to full visible capacity as provided in Tariff regulations, or
 - (b) load one 50 foot rail car to full visible capacity with a sufficient overage for a minimum trailer car as provided in Tariff regulations."

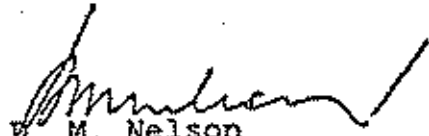
