INTERROGATORY NO. 95:

Identify any and all persons attending [between 1930 and 1980], on behalf of Defendant, any predecessor or any related company, any meetings, seminars or symposiums held by the trade organizations, associations, or other entities identified in response to Interrogatory No. 94.

ANSWER:

Defendant currently is not aware whether any persons attended on behalf of Warner Electric any meetings, seminars or symposiums held by the Power Transmission Distributor Association or Society of Automotive Engineers, or the Outdoor Power Equipment Institute other than attending scheduled meetings of a local chapter of the Society of Automotive Engineers, but the dates of attendance are not known and may not be in the time frame. Defendant believes, however, that it is likely that employees of Warner Electric Brake & Clutch Company attended meetings of the Power Transmission Distributor Association. See Answer to Interrogatory No. 96, which is incorporated herein as if fully rewritten. Further, an employee, in 1987 or 1988, may have attended a symposium on fibers in friction materials sponsored by The Asbestos Institute.

INTERROGATORY NO 96:

Did any officer, employee, agent or representative of Defendant, of any predecessor, or of any related company, serve, at any time [between 1930 and 1980], as:

- (a) an officer, director or official of any trade organization, association or entity identified in response to Interrogatory No. 94?
