Purpose of the Meeting:
Per my conversation with Ryan Jackson, Mr. Littlefair would like to meet with Administrator Pruitt to discuss the recent technological advancements in terms of natural gas vehicles and how it will help to address issues in non-attainment areas under the Clean Air Act. The new generation of Near Zero NOx emissions natural gas engines, while using renewable natural gas, has an emissions profile that can compete, and in many cases exceed, the emissions profile of electric vehicles when drawing electricity from the grid.
