For your information, I am attaching a sheet that contains several alternates that we gave some consideration to.

If this form of sign appears all right to you, I would appreciate your suggestions as to how we might handle the matter with the Office of the Surgeon General. We can correspond on the matter directly from here or leave it to you. There is also the question of consultation with DuPont since it is in the interest of all of us to have consistency.
