Senate Majority Leader Mitch McConnell announced Tuesday that the Senate will hold a vote to proceed to a measure to repeal Obamacare early next week.

The vote is expected to fail, as three Senate Republicans - Lisa Murkowski of Alaska, Susan Collins of Maine and Shelley Moore Capito of West Virginia - have already said they won't vote to advance the bill. McConnell can only lose two GOP senators on the vote.

House Majority Leader Kevin McCarthy (R-Calif.) has instructed lawmakers to keep their schedules light, in case the Senate passes Obamacare repeal legislation and the House comes under pressure to act.

"While last votes are currently scheduled to take place tomorrow, Members are advised that - pending Senate action on health care - the House schedule is subject to change," McCarthy's announcement to members reads. "All Members should remain flexible in their travel plans over the next few days. Further information regarding potential additional items will be relayed as soon as possible."
