In a letter of October 24 Ed Edwards suggested that we consider labeling our Kaylo products similarly to that now being done by J-M. This would mean that we would put on a statement similar to the following: Hazardous product and respirator should be worn. I would appreciate your advising what steps you are going to take in facing this problem and the possibility of including this statement on our curtains.

I would also like Marshall's suggestions in this regard as it involves not only protecting ourselves now, but the legal liability we might get into on claims brought against us before we started to label the product in this way.

We must make a decision with all the facts at hand, and we should be given direction and guidance from Marshall before a decision is made. Will look for you to follow through on the above and keep me advised.
