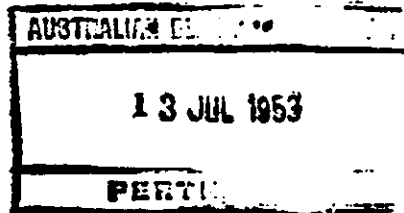

Dear Sir,

I acknowledge receipt of your letter of July 4th which I received today. I also acknowledge receipt of your telegram. Unfortunately your letter was not to hand when I sent the telegram.

In answer to your queries, I would advise as follows: -

1. Basic Furniture:

The houses are supplied with:

- (a) Dining Room table, sideboard and 4 chairs.
- (b) Kitchen table and 2 chairs.
- (c) Bedroom: Dressing table and double bed and either built in or separate wardrobe.
- (d) Single stretchers are issued as required.
- (e) Blinds supplied.
- (f) Built in cupboards in the kitchen.
- (g) Refrigerator.
- (h) Two lounge chairs.

No bedding except mattresses and pillows, no cutlery, no crockery, no cooking utensils, no curtains, and no linen.

2. Water Supply and Sanitation.

The town water supply comes from a spring in Western Gorge and is piped to a head tank in the town. Residents are allowed 45,000 gallons per annum. Excess at the rate of 2/- per 1000 gallons. Each house has its own septic tank and flush toilet. Houses are supplied with shower and bath and chip heaters.

Termination of Services:

Each party to give a minimum of two months notice of intention to discontinue engagement.

Should you desire any further particulars, I shall be glad to furnish them.

I would appreciate your telegraphed advice followed by your written confirmation of your acceptance or rejection of this offer.

If you accept, would you please indicate the date on which you could commence duties at Wittenoom.

I imagine you would travel by car. However, should you desire to come by air, I shall arrange air travel through Mr. Wallace.
