2 leaves, we have Mr. Grewe and Mrs. Grewe and that
3 gives us another amount that will be left over
4 after -- that would be potentially available for
5 others.

6 So the importance of Mrs. Grewe's life
7 expectancy is in determining the size of the household
8 over the period of 1993 to the year 2001.

9 Q And what is the source for the life
10 expectancy table that you rely on?

11 A The life expectancy tables are published by
12 the Federal Government, by the federal agency which is
13 the National Center for Disease Control, and the
14 organization within that is the National Center for
15 Health Statistics.

16 And they publish something called a Vital
17 Statistics of the United States and in it it has the
18 various life tables, and the life tables are arranged
19 by race and by gender.

20 So we look -- in the case of this particular
21 case, we look at the life expectancy at the time of
