

1 Q And you read that sometime in 1968?

2 A '66.

3 Q '66. And then you looked at that and you
4 saw the -- you looked at some of the bibliographies in
5 there as to the various articles that were discussed?

6 A Well, when I did the older review in '78, I
7 used Selikoff's article as a guide to look back.

8 The easiest way to do research on a topic is
9 to do an excellent review of the topic by somebody
10 that is a recognized authority and let them do the
11 work for you.

12 They have already looked up all of the
13 literature and listed what they think are the most
14 important articles and you look at those.

15 Otherwise you go through the Index Medicus
16 and go through hundreds and hundreds of titles to find
17 out what are the best articles.

18 Q I think you testified in the past, when you
19 did this literature review that started sometime in
20 1978 or '79 --

21 A Late '78.
