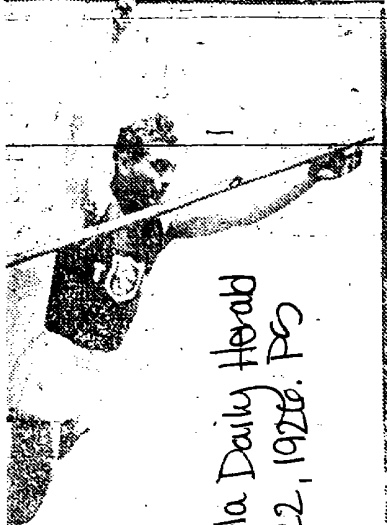

Method of such submission either by initiative or referendum.

The Statute of 1921, page 1654, provides for the classification of municipal corporations, and in subdivision 3 further provides that the board of trustees may, at any time, cause a census to be taken in such matter, and under such regulations as such board may BY ORDINANCE direct.

Census No Exception

In the initiative and Referendum Act there are a few exceptions excluded from the operations thereof, but the TAKING OF A CENSUS IS NOT ONE OF THEM.
