I would also like to give you an update on progress on the marine studies on EEA-NH4 initiated last year:

- Sea urchin – study complete, draft report under review.
- Oyster study – several delays in this study due to a lab error and then a poor batch of oysters, study now underway again.

I would hope that the two study reports would be shared with you towards the end of Q1 2023 but don't have an exact date at this stage. The results of these studies should input to the RCR calculations that the EA have calculated.
