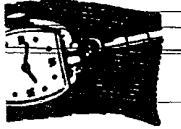

pear and answer the Complaint in an

vice upon you of this Summons, if served
within this County, or within thirty days
if served elsewhere
The purpose of said action is to quiet
the title to the premises and real estate
described in the complaint in said action
and hereinafter described, and to deter-
mine all and every claim, right title
estate, lien or interest of the said defend-
ants, or either or any of them, in the
real property described in the complaint
adverse to the said plaintiffs; that it be
decreed and adjudged by decree of said
Court that the said plaintiffs, MATT L
ROHR and JULIA B ROHR, his wife,
are the owners in fee of the real property
hereinafter described and that the
defendants, or any or either of them,
have no estate, right, title or interest
wherein, nor any claim, right, title or

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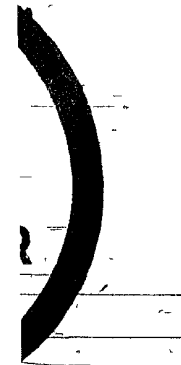
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
