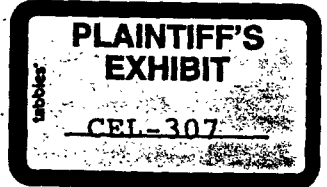

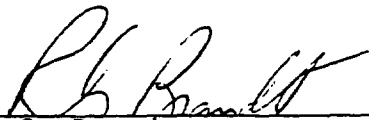
Dear Mr. Stewart:

The Celanese Plastics and Specialties Company at Bishop, Texas plans to renovate and salvage approximately 500 linear feet of 2 and 3 inch piping covered with insulation material, parts of which may contain friable asbestos. This renovation work is scheduled to begin March 17 and be completed by April 11, 1980. The insulation will be removed and landfilled in the designated asbestos landfill located on the plant site. All the precautions outlined in 40 CFR 61.20 - 61.25 will be observed.

This letter will serve as a notification of this work, as required by 40 CFR 61.22 (d) (2). The attached data sheet lists all the pertinent data.
