**Subject:** Take action on Use of Methylene Chloride

Dear Ms. Beck, Mr. Morris, Ms. Corado and Mr. Parsons,

I am writing to you to ask you to take action to ban methylene chloride, after learning of the awful and preventable death of a family friend's brother's death [Ex. 6 Personal Privacy (PP)] recently died tragically and much too young, after using a methylene chloride based paint stripper in his recently started business.

EPA is aware of the harmful and toxic effects of this chemical and its well documented health effects and had been planning to issue a ban. That is the right thing to do just as other countries in Europe and elsewhere have done.

You are in a position to take action. Prevent tragic accidents and spare other families from the heartbreak of what happened to [Ex. 6] taking appropriate and necessary action now. Please reconsider your delay in imposing a ban (HQ-OPPT-2016-0231-0001) on this dangerous and deadly chemical.
