I understand that you have discontinued some uses of the Aroclor twelve-hundred series, which may lead to escape of these materials into the environment. I would like to express my pleasure at your action. I should be interested in knowing what uses are eliminated by this action.

Further, I wondered if you have any information on the metabolism of these compounds? Our findings indicate that there is differential storage of the higher chlorinated compounds. Also is there any information on differential toxicity within the 1200 series? I have your bulletins O-FF/1, O/PL-311A and O/PL-306 but would appreciate any other information you have available on these materials.
