Senator Kuchel and Repre-
sentative Yorty traded verbal
punches in Los Angeles. Ku-
chel, interviewed on a tele-
cast by Lewis K. Gough, form-
er national commander of the
American Legion, said that
Yorty "has a legislative record
of zero" in the four years he
has been in Washington . . .
and one of the poorest at-
tendance records in the House
of Representatives, which
probably accounts for the fact
he has not done anything for
California or even for his own
district."

Yorty said California will pro-
vide a clear test for farmer re-
action to the policies of Secre-
tary Benson. He said that Ku-

chel has supported Benson's
lowering of farm price supports.
"My voting record speaks for it-
self," said Yorty. "I have always
voted for at least 90 per cent
parity, not only for basics but
for other farm products."

U.S. Atty. Gen. Herbert
Brownell Jr. addressed a \$100-
a-plate Republican dinner rally
in San Francisco last night. He
predicted that California would
elect Republican congressman
all along the line and declared:
"I want you to elect Tom
Kuchel. He has served the state
well."

Edward Roybal, campaigning
the past four days in Northern
California, announced he would
return to Los Angeles Sunday
to campaign in that county.
