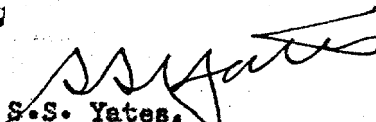

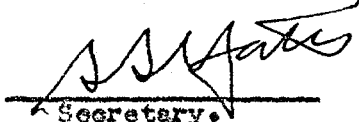
After a general discussion of the developments during the past few months and the results of the experiments as obtained to date, it was

RESOLVED, that Mr. Charles Wesley Dunn be authorized to meet Mr. Wharton of the U.S. Department of Agriculture to arrange for a Government examination of the research work done to date at Camajoharie, in connection with the centrifuging and cleaning of the material. At this meeting, our technical advisers will be present, if possible, and also the technical representative of each of the interested companies.

It was arranged that each of the owning companies send samples of finished gum periodically to the other two companies for check of the analyses. The details of this are to be arranged by the operating staff of the three companies.

Mr. Yates was instructed to get in touch with a representative of the Clark Brothers Chewing Gum Company at once to ask him to come to New York for a discussion with Mr. Dunn as to the development of operating control in this plant.

Mr. Yates was also instructed to obtain samples, as far as possible, of all the gum now on the market and to send these samples to Dr. Kehoe for test as to the "X" content.
