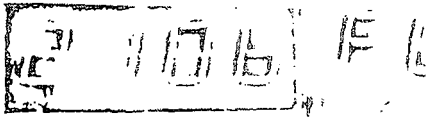

THE authorization of Form CA-1456 dated February 16, 1915 was received to
begin construction. Also the assignment of Assistant Colonel F. C. Preference
rating AA-3, and Serial Number 24-5777 for the purchase of approved
materials, machinery and equipment required to complete the following projects:
Alter Dust System at the Mining Tanks and the Lead Sows. Install New Dust
System at the steam houses in the Magnesia Department

This approval was granted by RFB, subject to the following conditions:

1. The total cost of the entire project shall not exceed the sum of \$4,000.00. (2).
~~exceeding (\$)~~ ~~estimated~~ on hand.
2. Project must be completed by August 16, 1915.
3. Unless construction is started or initial equipment is installed within
90 days after the issuance date of this authorization, the
authorization to construct or acquire facilities and the right to use the
allotment symbol and preference rating is automatically revoked. Approval
of the War Production Board must be secured for extension of time or re-in-
statement of the authorization.

4. The WPA in issuing this authorization relied on the statements and representations made by JM in the application. Failure to abide by these statements and representations constitutes a violation of this authorization and grounds for its immediate cancellation. In addition, failure of JM to abide by any of the conditions imposed in this authorization also constitutes grounds for its immediate cancellation.

5. No materials or equipment may be acquired under this authorization or incorporated in the project except as permitted under the provisions of Division I to CIP Regulation 6 and Circular A CIP Regulation 6, and to other applicable WPA Orders and Regulations. Deviation from such limitations is permitted only if specifically authorized below.

6. The following deviation from the construction limitations and from the restrictions imposed by WPA Regulations 6 are permitted:

Using sheet metal as required for heads, pipes and steel work.
