Health Safety Warning for UNIBESTOS Cartons

Gentlemen:

Now that the labor contract has been settled at Plant 7, I suggest we consider adding subject health safety warning to our UNIBESTOS cartons as promptly as practical.

We are aware of the wording, size, and location of the health warning messages as used by our competitors. I know of no reason why we should differ from their practice.

Unless there are reasons for a negative vote, I suggest we start the machinery to add such health warning so that our next reorder for UNIBESTOS cartons at each plant may be properly imprinted by the supplier.

Will this course of action be in line with your thinking?
