LEAD FREE GLIDDEN HOUSE PAINT PRIMER Y-2251-C

We have completed our work on the development of Y-2251 Glidden House Paint Primer to make it lead-free. The cost savings is 21¢ per gallon. We are recommending that the formula be sent to Chicago Midwest Trade Sales to manufacture the first batch. We have recently learned they are using the last of their lead pigment W-423. As soon as a batch has been made in Chicago and approved by Mr. Koenig, we ask that a sample be sent to my attention. We will then recommend sending the formula to the other regions. In the meantime, Mr. Haviland can be working with the purchasing agents of the other plants to phase-out the stocking of W-423.
