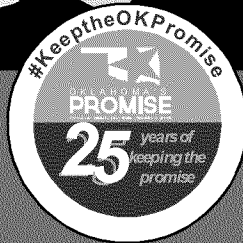


Re: Invitation to Speak – Oklahoma’s Promise Day at the State Capitol
