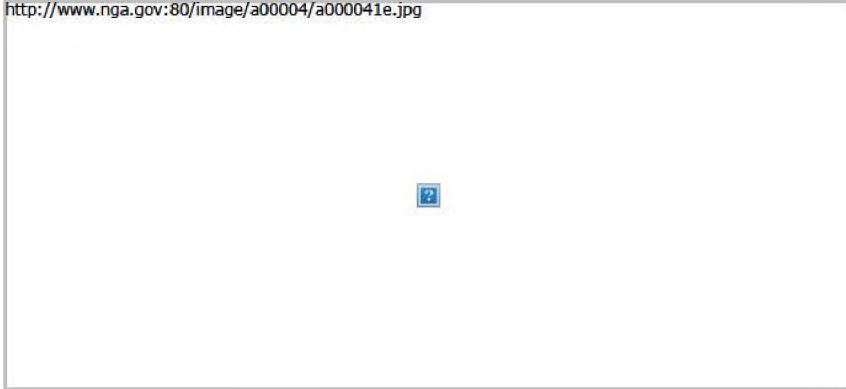
George Inness (artist)

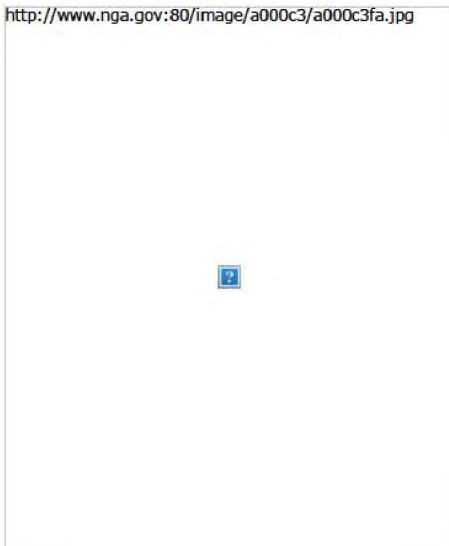
Thomas Chambers (artist)
