In preparing a report on the completion of the phase-out program for our PCB/PCT product line, I will need from you in writing before July 7 your certification that:

1. Sales of PCB heat transfer fluids in the U.S. were terminated on December 15, 1972 except to Goodyear Tire and Rubber Company. Sales to Goodyear will terminate on August 7, 1972.
2. All known PCB heat transfer systems in food processing or food-related operations in the U.S. have been converted to non-PCB fluids.
3. Sales of PCB heat transfer fluids to remaining world markets were terminated on January 31, 1972.
4. Sales of PCB industrial fluids in areas outside the U.S. and Canada were terminated on January 31, 1972 except for industrial fluids for the German mining industry.
5. Sales of PCT industrial fluids were terminated worldwide on June 30, 1972.
6. Sales of PCB dielectric fluids in the U.S. were terminated on January 15, 1972 except to those approved customers who satisfy Monsanto's special requirements.
7. Sales of PCB dielectric fluids in Canada were terminated on January 31, 1972 except to those approved customers who satisfy Monsanto's special requirements.
8. Sales of PCB dielectric fluids in remaining world markets were terminated on March 31, 1972 except to those approved customers who satisfy Monsanto's special requirements.
