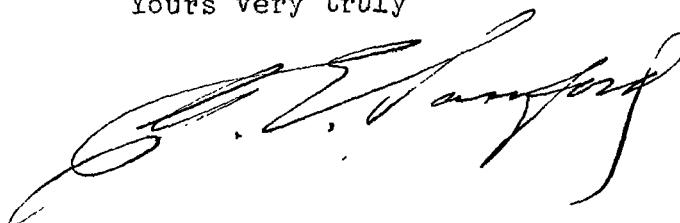
Dear Dr. Winslow:
